### **2009 Lodging for NCGLNAC Events**

**To receive this special rate, you must mention that you are attending an NCGLNAC Great Lakes Native American Event.**

#### **Lodging:**

**Hoosier Inn** in Portland (260-726-7113): rooms at \$50 for one bed and \$55 for two beds per night, \$5 per additional person plus tax, including a free continental breakfast. Reservation deadline is one week before events. Pets allowed.

**Super 8** in Portland (260-726-8888): rooms for \$55 for one bed and \$59 for two beds per night and \$5 per additional person plus tax, including a free continental breakfast. Reservation deadline is one week before events. Amenities include an exercise and a meeting room.

**Holiday Inn Express** in Portland (260-726-6688) offers \$85 per room per night plus tax and includes a hot breakfast. No deadline before events. Amenities include an indoor pool, hot tub, an exercise room and a meeting room.

**Bearcreek Farms** near Bryant (260-997-6822) offers rooms with two queen beds for \$45 per night plus tax with a reservation 30 days in advance. Otherwise the rooms are \$60 per night plus tax. Amenities include a full shopping experience, GoodTimes Theatre, an indoor water park, and a full-service restaurant.

**Hilltop Farm Bed & Breakfast** near Portland (260-726-8029). Pets are allowed.

**Schug House Inn Bed and Breakfast** in Berne (260-589-2303).

#### **Camping**

**The Jay County Fairgrounds** (Morton at Votaw Streets in Portland) for \$10 per night for primitive, \$15 per night for electricity only, or \$15 per night for full-hook-ups for RVs. Outdoor restrooms and showers are open from May 1 to October 1. One water fill station and one dump station is located on the grounds. Camp registration and payment must be sent in with the event registration. The 1½ day cultural arts classes, the 2½ day classes and the Fall Friendship Fire are held at the Jay County Fairgrounds.

**The Tri-State Antique Tractor & Gas Engine Association Grounds**, 1010 Morton Street in Portland: Camping is \$15 per night, with or without electricity. There are no full hook-ups. Four complete dump stations and water fill stations are on the grounds, as are restrooms and showers. The Gathering of Great Lakes Nations Pow wow is held at the Tri-State Grounds.
